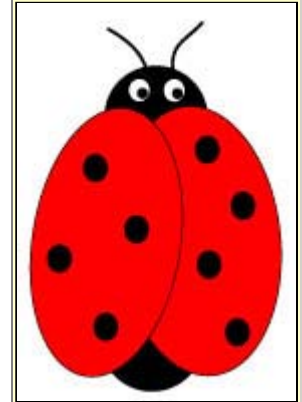


# Ladybug Magnet

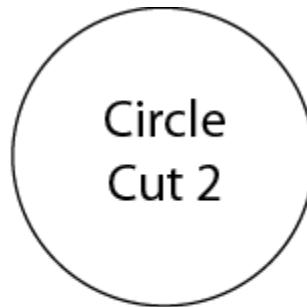
<i>What you'll need:</i>	red & black craft foam 6 black circle (sequins, foam or buttons) 2 black pipecleaners 5cm (2") long	2 google eyes scissors	glue small magnet
--------------------------	---	---------------------------	----------------------

## Instructions *(for patterns see page 2)*

- 1 Cut out two black foam circles.  
Cut out two red elipses.
- 2 Lay 2 red elipses vertically side by side.  
Overlap the two slightly.  
Glue the elipses together to make the ladybug wings.
- 3 Glue one black circle behind the top of the elipses.  
This is the head.  
Make sure there is enough black showing to put on the face!
- 4 Let the ladybug sit until the glue is dried.
- 5 Glue one black circle behind the bottom of the ladybug.  
Only show a little bit of black.
- 6 Bend the pipecleaners to make antennae whatever shape you want.
- 7 Glue antennae on the back of the head.
- 8 Glue the google eyes on to give your bug a funny face.
- 9 Glue the spots on your bug's wings.  
Your spots can be sequins, foam or buttons!
- 10 Let your little bug dry again.
- 11 Flip your bug over and stick on the magnet.  
Use glue or an adhesive magnet.
- 12 When your bug dries, display it on the fridge!
