

My Little Angel Picture Frame

What you'll need:

21 popsicle sticks	10 cm (4") of thick ribbon	glue
1 gold pipecleaner	33 cm (13") of thin ribbon	a thin marker
0.5 cm x 7.5cm (1/4" x 3")	1 bead head with a hole	scissors
piece of white craft foam	through the center	

Instructions

1 Lay 2 popsicle sticks end to end horizontally with another stick centered below and parallel to these.

2 Glue 12 sticks vertically between the sticks in (1). The tops are glued to the two sticks end to end and the bottoms are glued to the other horizontal stick.

3 Glue a stick on top of the left most and right most vertical sticks.

4 Glue the foam horizontally between the sticks in (3) about one inch from the bottom.

5 Glue 2 sticks horizontally over the foam (hiding it).
Glue 2 more sticks horizontally across the top of the frame.

6 Let the frame sit until all of the glue is dry.

7 Tie the thin ribbon onto the sticks at the top of the frame.

8 Cut the pipecleaner in half.
Use one half to make wings for an angel.

9 Gather the thick ribbon and hold wings up against the ribbon.
Twist one end of the other half of pipecleaner around the ribbon and the wings. This is the angel's body.
Bend the end piece of pipecleaner upwards.

10 Feed the angel head onto the pipecleaner.
Make a halo from the pipecleaner remaining.

11 Glue the angel to your frame and write "My Little Angel" with a thin marker.

12 When everything is dry, this homemade gift will tug at the heart strings of any family member or close friend!
